

Tensbüttel to Dellbrück

23.1	Tensbüttel, at the fire station	0m
23.2	W on Dorfstraße to end; L on Hauptstraße; R on Süderhackerweg; ahead; bend L into forest then R; L at end of forest, then R to T-junction.	2210m
23.3	R at T-junction then L at next; cross bridge and then bend R at farm buildings; out to main road; cross, and turn L along R pavement to junction with Bargenstedterfeld.	1960m

The red and blue stripes running down the pages in these documents (and separating the text from captions and users' notes) are the heraldic colours of the *Land* of Schleswig-Holstein, through which the route passes.

23.1 This section of the walk starts outside the fire station in Tensbüttel, about half-way along the length of Dorfstraße.

There is a bus stop here, with occasional buses.

This is a viable point for pick-up or drop-off by a supporting car and driver.

23.2 From the fire station, walk along Dorfstraße in a westerly direction. Immediately on the left is a large building: it is a special residential school for blind and deaf-blind children.

In this part of the village, there are some older brick buildings dating from the nineteenth century. Aspects of the architecture may be found in similar buildings in areas of the United States of America which were settled by North Germans. Hamburg was the major emigrant port, and many of the ships made their way up the St Lawrence towards the interior, so these buildings have echoes all the way from Syracuse to the mid-West. There, the fashion for brick construction declined, but features of the houses remained.

At the end of Dorfstraße, turn left onto Hauptstraße. After a mere 60m, turn right onto Süderhackerweg. Pass the end of Dellbrückweg on your right, and continue towards woodland ahead.

The path first borders the woodland on the left; after a left-hand bend, the path plunges into the wood. A right-hand bend soon maintains the generally westerly direction within the forest; at the western end of the forest, the path takes a left bend (keeping the trees on the left), then takes a right-hand bend to leave the forest behind.

About 300m on from the right-hand bend, you will reach a T-junction.

23.3 Turn right at the T-junction, and continue for about 700m to the next junction, where turn left, now pointing west-south-west.

After a couple of bends, you will cross a bridge and proceed to a right-hand bend by a farm. From here, the road leads out to the main road at Dellbrück.

Cross the road, and turn left to follow it for 120m to the next junction on the left.

This is the end of this section of the Nord-Ostsee-Wanderweg.

There is a bus stop here, with occasional services running on the route between Albersdorf and Meldorf.
